Procedures for after-school clubs

After-school sessions are run by professional coaches or specialists. If your child attends an after-school club, they will be escorted to the club at the end of the day by a member of staff. If you are staying after school to watch your child in the club, please inform the club provider who will advise you where you should be. Please be aware that our cleaners are on site after school and they need to access all classrooms and areas.

Parenting services
